The Partnership between TFSR Cymru and Kalwande Vocational College has been officially inaugurated by the signing of the Memorandum of Understanding, which will guide both parties in their joint aim of reducing poverty in a small part of rural Tanzania.

You will have seen the alfresco workshop that our staff are working with in our last Newsletter. In just their first month they have raised the amazing sum of 4.5 million Tanzanian shillings (the equivalent of nearly £1500).

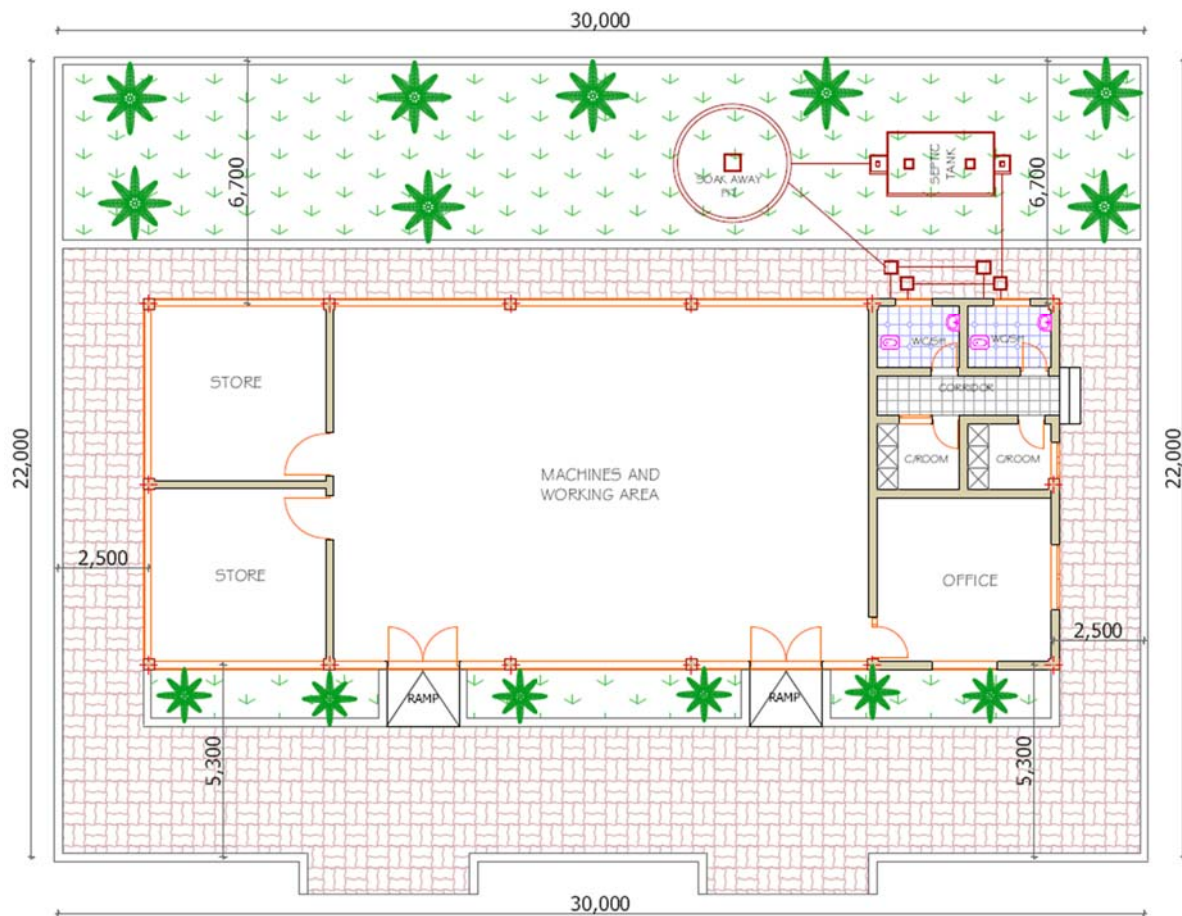
That income will pay their wages and help the running costs of the College.
