The New Workshop at Kalwande

We knew from the very start that funding new infrastructure at Kalwande was going to be expensive, but the imperative was there for a purpose built workshop to refurbish all the tools we send.

There were no opportunities available for grant funding but our volunteers have raised a huge amount of money this year and we are happy to report that the new workshop is already 80% complete.

Work started, breaking ground at the end of May. In the 6 months following, the foundations were laid, the walls were built; the steel reinforced structural columns, lintels and ring beam were cast in situ. While that was ongoing, the Kalwande fabrication and welding staff constructed the 9 steel roof trusses.

In the last two weeks these have been raised and fixed in place, together with the corrugated steel sheet roof covering.

The next phases will be the windows and doors, wiring and plumbing, and fitting out. Lastly the exterior walls will be rendered and painted.

Here's some photos of the work in progress. Note the complete absence of machinery; everything was done with manual labour and no sign of anything that you would see on a UK building site to conform with health and safety regulations!
